

Research – FreeGenData.com - A Genealogy Links Database, i.e., a search tool to help you locate free genealogy databases and transcriptions on the web

I collect free genealogy links. I call it a hobby within a hobby. I have been doing my families' genealogy for over 30 years. I started collecting genealogy links about two years ago when I was a volunteer doing consults on Friday Nights from 7 to 10 PM at a local Irish genealogy library. The library had three types of consults: scheduled, walk-ins and phone. Because I was the newest volunteer, my workload was mostly walk-ins and phone. I found walk-ins to be extremely challenging because there was no advance preparation and because they were usually significantly less than the three hour scheduled consult. With help from my peers, I collected genealogy links.

Recently, I found FreeGenData.com. I was really amazed at the collection of links. As of September 17, 2013, there are **16,875** links in the database. On the web site's first page, it indicates that there were: 1898 Cemetery links, 406 Passenger List links, 74 Royalty and Nobility links and 29 Disaster links.

I have organized my own links documents by locality. I include personal links by surname. There is no surname search in FreeGenData.com. I have to resist the urge to harvest and incorporate FreeGenData.com's links.

The following table is simply constructed to show FreeGenData.com's

Sometimes, I find that the link does not work. Often it is because it has been re-hosted. I usually copy and paste the hyperlink's underlined text into my browser to find it. It is simple but it does not always work.
